Assessing the Viability of Jetties Along the River Gambia

As part of our ongoing efforts to assess the viability of jetties along the River Gambia, the consultancy firm Royal HaskoningDHV, supported by partners CityScape Associates and our project team, is currently conducting field surveys and data collection. Engagement with the jetty site communities is crucial for obtaining accurate and relevant data. Interviews with stakeholders are providing valuable input for the socio-economic study and serving as indicators for tourism potential.

Simultaneously, technical inspection surveys of the riverside are being conducted to assess the current status of jetties. This will inform us whether existing jetties can be rehabilitated or if new concept designs need to be prepared.

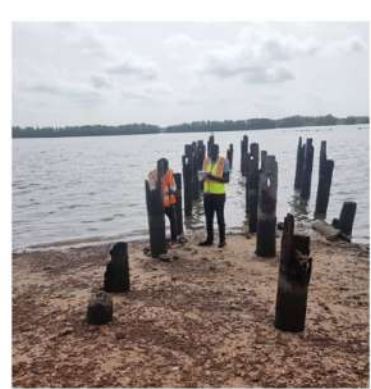
This collaborative approach will help us develop a comprehensive understanding of the sites and ensure the successful planning and implementation of the jetties, contributing to the sustainable development of the River Gambia region.

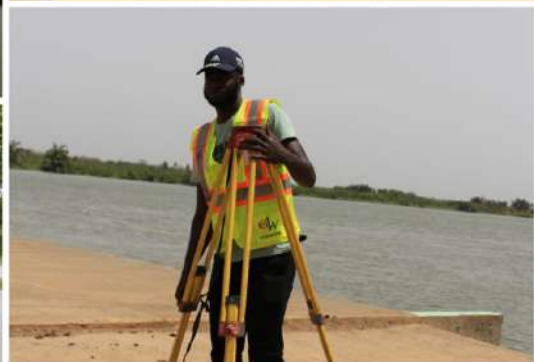
